The new home will feature one central kitchen and a fully equipped servery attached to the dining room in each of the four homesteads. Meals will be prepared in the main kitchen and then brought to each homestead, where the serveries will heat and plate them before they're served to residents. The serveries will also be used to prepare snacks and beverages throughout the day.

With construction moving along quickly, these spaces are one step closer to supporting the homelike dining experience that will be at the heart of each homestead.

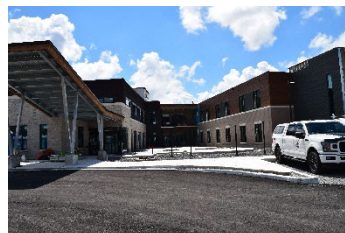
A Degree of Comfort
