
A Great Team


Acts of Kindness

EQUIPMENT PROFILE

One of the Foundation's latest equipment purchases is a pediatric scope. It is used to visualize the large bowel. It has a smaller diameter than an adult scope, which helps to navigate tight corners in patients who have had previous surgeries. Endoscopies are performed to aid in the diagnoses and treatment of many bowel cancers, polyps, bleeds and pathology.

"We are fortunate enough to have the latest in technology to accommodate this large patient population," notes Karen Lydiatt, Team Leader, Perioperative Unit. "Thank you to our donors!"






The 20th annual Christmas Wish Tree program provides a way to honour or remember your family and friends with a gift to the WDMH Foundation.
