Our total patient volume through WDMH is approximately 100,000 per year, of which 22,000 are Emergency Department, 300 surgical in-patient, 3800 day surgeries, 750 obstetrical deliveries, and 17, 000 ambulatory clinic visits. In addition to family physicians working within the hospital setting there are also surgeons, internists, obstetrician/gynecologists, midwives, anesthetists, ENT, radiologists and a cardiologist on-site. Acute referrals are typically to Ottawa, 30 minutes away.
